

**LOCAL LAW NO. 1, 1996**

**A LOCAL LAW TO AMEND LOCAL LAW NO. 1 FOR THE YEAR 1989 – FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION AS AUTHORIZED BY THE NEW YORK STATE CONSTITUTION, ARTICLE IX, SECTION 2, AND ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION LAW, ARTICLE 36**

**ADOPTED BY TOWN OF CAMBRA TOWN BOARD MAY 2, 1996**

Be it enacted by the town Board of the Town of Cambria as follows:

**SECTION 3.0 GENERAL PROVISIONS**

Section 3.2 is amended as follows:

**3.2 BASIS FOR ESTABLISHING THE AREAS OF SPECIAL FLOOD HAZARD:**

The areas of special flood hazard have been identified by the Federal Emergency Management Agency in a scientific and engineering report entitled "Flood Insurance Study Town of Cambria, New York, Niagara County" dated March 30, 1983 with Flood Insurance Rate Maps enumerated on Map Index No. 3604990001-0020 dated September 30, 1983 and with accompanying Flood Boundary and Floodway Maps enumerated on Map Index No. 360499 0001-0002 dated September 30, 1983 and LETTER OF MAP REVISION ISSUED ON FEBRUARY 26, 1996 AS FEMA CASE #96-02-13p AND INCORPORATING REVISIONS TO TRIBUTARY T-5A OF TWELVE MILE CREEK ON PANEL 0005B.
