LOCAL LAW NO. 5 OF THE YEAR 1998

A LOCAL LAW TO PROVIDE THAT THE TERM OF OFFICE OF THE TOWN CLERK OF THE TOWN OF CAMBRIA HEREAFTER ELECTED SHALL BE FOUR (4) YEARS

ADOPTED BY TOWN OF CAMBRIA TOWN BOARD AUGUST 31, 1998, SUBJECT TO MANDATORY REFERENDUM

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Cambria as follows:

Section One: Notwithstanding the provisions of Section 24 of the Town Law, the term of office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Cambria, elected at the election in November, 2001, and of all Town Clerks in the Town of Cambria elected thereafter, shall be four years.

Section Two: This Local Law shall be subject to mandatory referendum and shall take effect, subject to compliance with the Provisions of Section 23, subdivision 1 of the Municipal Home Rule Law when filed in the Office of the Secretary of State, pursuant to Section 27 of such law.
