TOWN OF CAMBRIA

ORDINANCE PROHIBITING STANDING ON CERTAIN HIGHWAYS WITHIN THE TOWN OF CAMBRIA

ADOPTED November 5, 1964

In pursuance of the authority conferred by Article 40-A of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York, the Town Board of the Town of Cambria, County of Niagara, and State of New York, hereby ordains and enacts the following Traffic Ordinances:

Except in an emergency or in compliance with the direction of a peace officer, no vehicle shall be parked or permitted to stand on the following highways:

- 1. On both sides of Old Shawnee Road between Route 31 SH 9094 and Route 425 SH 729, a distance of 1500 +/- feet.
- 2. On both sides of Cambria Road from its intersection with Upper Mountain Road C.R. –33A northerly on Cambria Road for a distance of 1500 feet.

A violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished in accordance with

the provisions of the Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York relating to Traffic Infractions.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
