RESOLUTION RATIFYING LETTER TO NYS LIQUOR AUTHORITY

Upon a motion duly made by Councilwoman Kroening and seconded by Councilman Bush, it was resolved to ratify letter sent by Town Supervisor dated 9/27/07 to New York State Liquor Authority agreeing to waive the thirty day notice required by the Alcoholic Beverage Control law relating to the application by Thaxton's Dinner House for license renewal.

PRESENTATION OF 2008 TENTATIVE BUDGET

The Town Clerk presented the 2008 Tentative Budget to Board members.

Supervisor Ellis presented an overview of the budget with total appropriations of \$4,373,076. The Tentative Budget calls for a total tax rate of \$4.721 per 1000 for those having sewer available – an increase of \$.072 per 1000 (+1.55%) and \$3.721 per 1000 for those not having sewer available – an increase of \$.072 per 1000 (+1.97%).

Budget meetings were scheduled for October 9th at 7 pm in the Community Building; October 16th at 7 pm in the Conference Room and October 17th at 7 pm in the Community Building.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned by motion made by Councilman Foe and seconded by Councilman Blackman.
