

**LOCAL LAW NO. 1 OF THE YEAR 1994**

**A LOCAL LAW AMENDMENT TO LOCAL LAW NO. 3 FOR 1991 ENTITLED  
“TOWN OF CAMBRIA RECYCLING LAW”**

**ADOPTED BY TOWN OF CAMBRIA TOWN BOARD APRIL 7, 1994**

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Cambria as follows:

New Section 2 (g)

“The Municipality may change classification of “nonrecyclables” to “recyclables” as defined herein in the event it determines that reclassification is cost effective or that economic markets exist for that product. The Municipality shall notify all generators of the change in classification.”

New Section 5 (a)

“The provisions of this ordinance or Local Law apply to commercial, industrial and institutional waste generators. In the event they do not have materials collected pursuant to law or contract they shall be responsible for components prior to being disposed of in any manner or solid waste left for collection or delivered by the generator at a Solid Waste Management facility. This material must be source separated.”
