

LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF THE YEAR 1998

**A LOCAL LAW PROVIDING A PARTIAL EXEMPTION FROM REAL PROPERTY TAXES
TO PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES WHO HAVE LIMITED INCOME**

ADOPTED BY TOWN OF CAMBRIA TOWN BOARD SEPTEMBER 10, 1998

Be it enacted by the Town Board of the Town of Cambria as follows:

Section 1. This local law is adopted pursuant to authority of Chapter 315 of the Laws of 1997, Real Property Tax Law, §459-c. All definitions, terms and conditions of such statute shall apply to this local law.

Section 2. Real property owned by a person with disabilities whose income is limited by such disabilities, and used as the legal residence of such person, shall be entitled to a partial exemption from taxation to the extent of 50% of assessed valuation when property is qualified pursuant to law.

Section 3. To be eligible for the exemption authorized by such section 459-c and implemented by this local law the maximum income of such person shall not exceed \$18,500.00 and further shall be reduced by 5% for each \$1,000.00 of income above said \$18,500.00.

Section 4. This local law shall take effect immediately upon its filing in the office of the Secretary of State.
