New York State Agriculture and Markets Law 25AA, Section 303-b requires an annual thirty-day period within which a land owner may submit a request for inclusion of land which is predominantly viable agricultural land within a certified agricultural district prior to the county established 8-year review period. The annual thirty-day period for Niagara County is June 1-30.

New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets Law, Article 25AA, section 303-c, requires that a public notice be posted. Please review the public notice below:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Niagara County is accepting proposals for inclusion of parcels in The Niagara County Agricultural District. A map of the current Agricultural District in Niagara County is available online at <http://gis2.erie.gov/HTML5/NiagaraCountyNY/>. A staff member at Cornell Cooperative Extension of Niagara County can assist you with this, by appointment only. New York State Department of Agriculture and Markets Law, Article AA, 303-b (1) requires an annual thirty (30) day period within which a land owner may submit a request for inclusion of land which is predominantly viable agricultural land within a certified agricultural district prior to the county established 8-year review period. Municipalities and landowners may propose an inclusion in the district between the dates of June 1, 2020 and June 30, 2020.
