

## **TOWN OF CAMBRIA**

### **ORDINANCE FOR THE PROTECTION, PRESERVATION AND CONSERVATION OF FRESHWATER WETLANDS IN THE TOWN OF CAMBRIA**

Adopted August 30, 1976

Be it ordained by the Town of Cambria, New York:

**SECTION I:** Adoption of an ordinance for the protection, preservation and conservation of freshwater wetlands in the Town of Cambria.

Pursuant to § 24-0501 of the New York State Freshwater Wetlands Act (Article 24 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law), the Town Board of the Town of Cambria shall fully undertake and exercise its regulatory authority with regard to activities subject to regulation under the Act in freshwater wetlands, as shown on the Freshwater Wetlands Map, as such map may from time to time be amended, filed by the Department of Environmental Conservation pursuant to the Act, and in all areas adjacent to any such freshwater wetland up to 100 feet from the boundary of such wetland. Such regulatory authority shall be undertaken and exercised in accordance with all of the procedures, concepts and definitions set forth in Article 24 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law and Title 23 of Article 71 of such law relating to the enforcement of Article 24, as such law may from time to time be amended, with the following exceptions, additions and modifications (§ 24-0501 (3) provides for a specification of any exceptions, additions and modifications to the procedures of Article 24. Please read the Department's August 6, 1976 "Criteria for reviewing Local Freshwater Wetland's Protection Ordinances and Laws Pursuant to the Freshwater Wetlands Act (Article 24 of the New York Environmental Conservation Law)" prior to making any exception, addition or modification to the provisions of Article 24.)

**EFFECTIVE DATE OF ORDINANCE:**

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its approval and publication as required by law.
