

TOWN OF CAMBRIA
WINTER PARKING ORDINANCE

Adopted: February 1, 1990

SECTION 1.

Definitions: For the purpose of this law the following terms shall have the meanings indicated:

Town Highway: Any town highway, town street or town road within the Town of Cambria.

Park or Parking: Means the standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading merchandise or passengers.

Person: Any person, firm, association, corporation or legal representative acting individually or jointly.

Vehicle: Every device in, upon, or by which any person or property is or may be transported or drawn upon a highway, except devices used exclusively upon stationary rails or tracks.

Superintendent: The duly elected Highway Superintendent for the Town of Cambria.

SECTION 2.

Legislative Intent: The purpose of this ordinance is to prohibit parking of vehicles and other debris upon the rights-of-ways of Town highways during the winter months in which snow removal occurs and to authorize the Highway Superintendent to have vehicles removed from Town highways that are parked in violation of this Ordinance prohibiting winter parking on Town highways.

SECTION 3.

Parking Limits: It shall be unlawful for any person to park any vehicle on a Town highway within the Town between the hours of 1:00

am and 7:00 am, from November 1st of any year to April 1st of the year immediately following.

SECTION 4.

Removal:

The Superintendent shall have the power to cause the removal of all vehicles that are in violation of this Ordinance.

SECTION 5.

Violations and Penalties:

A violation of this law shall constitute a traffic infraction and any person violating this law shall be liable to a fine of not more than two hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00) or the imprisonment for not more than fifteen (15) days or both for each such violation.
